NOTE: The Walong and Marcel sidings were connected by a second track in late 2016. This second track does not pass through tunnel N^o10 as does the first track. This has created a double-tracked section over 3 miles long, from MP 351.1 to MP 354.2

TEHACHAPI LIVE TRAIN CAMS operates two video cameras. Camera N^o1 is showing less than a mile of track, centered near MP 357 of Union Pacific's Mojave subdivision. Camera N^o2 is at MP 360.5, at the Tehachapi Depot Railroad Museum, south of the tracks. It may point to the east or to the west at the operator's discretion. The track nearest the cameras is referred to as Track N^o1 and is usually used for trains headed east towards Mojave. The other track, Track N^o2, is generally used for trains headed to the west, towards Bakersfield. In any camera view, trains that move to the right are moving in an easterly direction.
